Dear Parents

Over the past few years, Cherry Hinton Lions FC, as a club, has snowballed into a very large organisation, and it is only going to get bigger. It is anticipated that in season 2009/10, we could have around 16 teams – probably the largest club in the county. To help us to try and give you and your children the best possible service, we have devised a short survey to get your feedback on how we are currently doing, and what can be done to improve on what we do.

Please remember that every committee member is a volunteer, and the Club is a self funded organisation to allow an entry point into teaching football to boys and girls at grassroots level.

We ensure that all our managers/coaches undertake CRB checks and all have F.A. coaching qualifications. Every coach has attained their Level 1 coaching certificate and attended Emergency First Aid courses. We have two coaches who have undertaken and passed their Level 2 badges, and we have a couple of coaches currently undertaking their Level 3 (or UEFA B) badges. Once you have your Level 3 certificate, it means that you are qualified to teach at a Football Academy, some achievement I think you will agree. On top of this we have two qualified goalkeeping coaches within the Club. I am proud to say that I don't think many grassroots clubs have coaches trained to this standard, and all these courses are funded by the Club.
